THE PUYALLUP RIVER IS CLOSED TO DRIFT NET FISHING BETWEEN THE 11TH STREET BRIDGE AND THE PILINGS OF THE OLD RAILROAD BRIDGE IMMEDIATELY UPSTREAM FROM THE 11TH STREET BRIDGE.FISHERS ARE REQUIRED TO CHECK THEIR SET NETS ONCE EVERY 24 HOURS AND REPORT ALL CATCH NOT SOLD ON COMMERCIAL FISH TICKETS TO THE TRIBAL FISHERIES OFFICE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF LANDING OR RECORD THEM ON THE TAKEHOME SECTION OF YOUR FISH TICKET, JUST LET THE FISH BUYERS KNOW.
