SEE SOMETHING ... SAY SOMETHING ...

Every month we will focus specific pests that plague residents here in the Northwest. This month we will focus on cockroaches. With the holidays coming up, this will leave more food sources available for pests. Cockroaches feed on anything available to them. That is what makes them really hard to get rid of. They live in warm, small spaces and come out at night to feed. Cockroaches can cause serious allergic reactions such as asthma.

To prevent an infestation, you must keep your home free from clutter, as this is where they lay their egg cases, and you must also limit their food sources by maintaining a tidy household free from food debris.

Having cockroaches does not mean you have a messy home. Having clutter with food being left out can make you prone to infestation. There is an attachment that you can look at to reference the signs of a cockroach infestation. Please report all signs to the housing department as soon as you see them. This will ensure that it is taken care of before it becomes a serious health issue.
