Subject: Modification of ICDBG ARP (Grant number 22RP5312680)

Dear David Boyd, Director, Grants Management Division

The PTOI Housing Department and Tribe recognized the need to modify the currently approved ICDBG ARP (Grant number 22RP5312680) as follows: As the Waller Project is delayed due to permitting issues with Pierce County is not moving forward at this point in time, funding is still needed for building of low-income rental units to provide homes to needy families who are still experiencing the Covid-19 impacts. PTOI would like to change forms 4125 to reflect a new grant Period Performance End date of 12/31/2025, with a closeout at 3/30/26. Justification for the request for grant extension is shown below.

The Puyallup Tribe of Indians Housing department proposed modification of performance period requested is to continue the process for construction of the Waller Road Project. An amendment needs to be made in order to stay with in the implementation schedule previously approve to close out the ICDBG ARP funds in a timely manner. The Waller Road Project has been delayed due to circumstances out of our control with permitting issues with Pierce County with an easement issue. Another delay was due to a change of site design requested by Puyallup Tribe of Indians of Tribal Council to have a second exit for site for Emergency Services and Emergency Exit for tenants. Also delayed by making arrangements with legal, and PTOI Tribal Council to discuss issues with Pierce County on the permitting of the easement and other improvement requested by Pierce county due to the development of this Waller Road Project. The Puyallup Tribe of Indians Tribal Council did not agree with this issue; however still want to pursue moving forward with this project. This proposed amendment change will allow the housing department to build Low-Income Rental units which allow more units to service those clients waiting on our waiting lists and assist with some overcrowding in units that which assist in preventing, preparing for, and responding to COVID-19 due to the need to still meet this unmet need to assist our tribal elders with our community find decent, affordable low-income housing; and overcrowding.

The Puyallup Tribe of Indians Housing Department will post the amended ICDBG-ARP funds to be due to funds needing to be expedited due to the previous HUD-4125 Implementation schedule submitted needing to be meet within timeline approved to spend funds. The Waller Road Project also had unexpected delays with design change and permitting issues with Pierce County to proceed with construction of units.



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A new Citizen Participation will be provided by Puyallup Tribe of Indians website allowing residents an opportunity to comment on the proposed amendments for the implementation schedule and budget revisions to the ICDBG ARP. Citizen partcipation will be posted in regards to the Waller Road project

The Puyallup Tribe of Indians housing department has completed the design of the Waller Road Project and has put out a solicitation to meet construction bidders November 11, 2024. There was a great turnout from this solicitation. Preconstruction will begin in January 2025 with Construction ending before Janaury 2026. Closeout of the Waller Road March 30, 2026.
